

Hunton & Williams advises Sumaida + Khurana and LENY joint venture in \$65 million acquisition

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Manhattan, NY Hunton & Williams LLP has advised the joint venture between Sumaida + Khurana and LENY in its \$65 million acquisition and planned demolition and redevelopment of 611 West 56th St.

The transaction, which closed on September 20, will include the demolition of the vacant commercial building currently on the property, located on the West Side, and the development and re-purposing of the site into a 35-story (173,163 s/f) 80-unit residential condominium with retail components. The planned development has been designed by architect, Alvaro Siza, and will be his first project in the U.S.
