

BOMA of Buffalo tours Oishei Children's Hospital, led by Turner Construction and Kaleida Health

Buffalo, NY On Wednesday, September 20, The Building Owners & Managers Association of Buffalo (BOMA) had a privilege of being the last public tour of the highly anticipated Oishei Children's Hospital before it's opening in November at the September monthly meeting.

The tour, led by Turner Construction and Kaleida Health, included patient rooms, the ambulatory center and surgery rooms, as well as a visit into the extensive two-floor mechanical space. The facility will also include a green house. The tour guides were thorough in explaining many efficiency changes that make the hospital innovative from the nurse's station layouts to the facility management systems.

Lunch was hosted in the Conventus building prior to the tour with a brief presentation on the construction, planning, and organizing that has been underway during the 10-year project. Constellation, An Energy Company was the meeting sponsor. The event sold out with over 100 BOMA members and colleagues in attendance.

The vision for the new hospital is to be recognized as the innovator, the highest quality, highest value provider and partner, and regional referral center for women and children's health care for Kaleida Health, Western New York, and beyond. It will consolidate services in a 12-floor, 185 bed, free standing and modern facility. It is expected to be 500,000 s/f of environmentally-friendly medical office space, 85,000 s/f of which will be Women & Children's Hospital space and ambulatory care center.
