I was born in the Philippines, but moved to California when I was one. I went back to visit family often, and still do, and on those frequent visits to the provinces, I saw how the community had positively been impacted by commercial growth and economic expansion. For example, the first

national retailer, 7/11, opened in my father's hometown only three years ago and this helped begin the transformation of the area. This is what inspired me to work in a field that contributes to growth and community development. Improving real-estate investment decisions utilizing innovative data-analysis is very exciting.
