



Pennetta to serve as 2011 CIBS president, Schacker is new CIBS vice president

The Commercial Industrial Brokers Society of Long Island unveiled its slate of officers for 2011 and appointed two to its executive board.

David Pennetta succeeds Jeffrey Schwartzberg as president of the organization, starting a two-year term in January. Pennetta, an executive vice president at Oxford & Simpson Realty, Inc, served a previous term as president in 1998-1999.
