Projects include Ridgeway Shopping Center, Stamford, Conn.; Ferry Plaza, Newark, N.J.; The Village at Livingston, N.J.; New Roc City, New Rochelle, N.Y.; and Watchung Commons, Watchung, N.J. and Palisades Court, Englewood, N.J. More recently, Perlmutter Properties joined in an association with G.E. Grace & Co., Inc. and Seeman Real Estate to form Resolution Realty Network, Inc. to assist companies to reposition and optimize the value of their distressed real estate assets.
