Accordingly a \$200,000 move budget specifying corrugated boxes will be reduced to \$140,000-\$150,000 by using Tyga-Box because it is highly efficient at reducing move labor due to its superior stacking height. Tyga-Box generally delivers exponential returns of 5X to its clients as the rental cost is in range of \$8,000-10,000.

Tyga-Box is the safest moving system because of its non-tip bottomless dolly making it foolproof for end-user stakeholders to avoid accidental injury. Tyga-Box is the most gender-friendly system, having been designed by a woman cognizant of the importance of ease of use and lightweight strength. As a result, ergonomically designed Tyga-Boxes or dollies weigh 20% less than other crates/dollies, and from a sustainability standpoint, use 20% less in resources to manufacture. Keeps contents in same order as original file drawer and files are in the right order for unpacking.
