



Jones Lang LaSalle completes 46,198 s/f interior build-out

Jones Lang LaSalle has completed the interior build-out of British Airways new offices on the 11th floor at 2 Park Ave. The airline leased 46,198 s/f at the landmark 964,000 s/f office building in early 2011.
