



Brookfield Office Properties names C&W exclusive leasing agent

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According to Cushman & Wakefield, Brookfield Office Properties Inc. has appointed the global real estate firm as leasing agent for its Manhattan West development, located on Ninth Ave. between West 31st and 33rd Sts.

Manhattan West, which is being designed by Skidmore Owings and Merrill LLP, will consist of two office towers of two million s/f each, a third of approximately one million s/f and a fourth, smaller building which will most likely be mixed-use space. A 1.5-acre public plaza will transect the site.

Construction is slated to begin in the first quarter of 2012, with the delivery of the first tower anticipated in late 2015.
