Jericho Tpke., while the Centereach store is located in the town's main shopping corridor off of Middle Country Rd. "Harbor Freight's business is booming across the Long Island area, and it shows no sign of letting up," said Weinstein. "We're happy to be able to play a part in this exciting expansion rollout for a high-growth mode retailer, and we look forward to continued business with Harbor Freight Tools." Weinstein's previous leases for the retailer are for stores in Bayshore and Commack, both in Suffolk County, and Hempstead, in Nassau County.
