Risk management topics included, insurance industry trends; recent legal decisions and Labor Law Â§240 Compliance; types of insurance coverage required for contractors and business protection; coverage for "upstream parties"; the impact of horizontal and vertical exhaustion; and steps to mitigate construction insurance challenges.
