It is a 8,236 s/f corner space on the third floor. The program consists of a large open office workstation, 11 offices, three executive offices, three conference rooms, and a board room that seats 14. CNB desired a well-designed, contemporary, corporate yet functional and welcoming space. The design meets this contemporary aesthetic with stones and ribbon striped mahogany accents. Even with the division between the executives and the workforce, the entire space functions as one. Designing a contemporary headquarters requires a skill of fusing corporate and comfort.
