

## 11-20-2013 - BOMA/NY to hold Super Bowl Preparedness seminar

All the action may be in New Jersey at the MetLife Stadium on February 2nd, 2014, but the week before Super Bowl XLVII comes to the New York area for the first time ever, Manhattan will be the site of pre-game activities that will impact almost every aspect of lifeâ€"including building operations.
