

Lightstone Group's Gantry Park reaches 60% leased

According to the Lightstone Group, Gantry Park Landing, which officially launched in July, has leased 120 of its 199 units. The Long Island City rental building is exclusively leased by aptsandlofts.com.

"By reaching 60% leased in this short time frame, it is evident that we've accomplished our goal of exceeding the expectations of Long Island City renters," said Mitchell Hochberg, president of The Lightstone Group, the developer of Gantry Park Landing. "Residents have been especially attracted to Gantry Park Landing's authentic industrial inspired design and the variety of high-end amenities offered exclusively within The Gantry Club."

Gantry Park Landing, located at 2-14 50th Ave., is a rental building near the Long Island City waterfront that provides residents a tight-knit community compared to some of the larger scale properties along the waterfront.

The Gantry Club is an array of indoor and outdoor amenities that are exclusively offered to the residents of Gantry Park Landing.
