



Stacom of CBRE speaks at WX breakfast meeting

Currently, Stacom is a vice chairman and head of the Investment Properties group for CBRE's New York Office. In the last four years, Stacom has twice been named the #1 Professional at CBRE globally, and twice named the #1 Investment Professional globally. Last year, she won the Robert T. Lawrence Memorial Award from the Real Estate Board of New York (REBNY).
