Christine Chipurnoi may have come to the insurance industry through a misunderstanding, but her 30-year career since has been the result of education, hard work, relationship building skills, networking and leadership skills.

Today, she develops, places and maintains insurance programs for regional, national and international clients, specializing in property, casualty, professional and loss sensitive insurance programs with special focus in construction, real estate, hospitality and retail. She is also a member of Wells Fargo's National Real Estate & Construction Practice, The National Hospitality Practice and Retail Practice groups.

"I strongly believe that the financial stability of a company is based on the three key relationships; legal expertise in the space, a strong accountant and a qualified, engaged insurance professional. This protects the company from unforeseen problems and reinforces their bottom line.
