



Marathon Energy supports Ronald McDonald House of NY; 20th Annual Niki Sedaris Memorial Walkathon

On May 16, Marathon supported the 20th annual Niki Sedaris Memorial Walkathon to benefit the Greek Division of Ronald McDonald House New York. According to Kostas Antonopoulos, chairman of the event, "The Greek Division of Ronald McDonald House New York serves as a lifeline to families from Greece, Cyprus and Greek Americans traveling to New York City to find life-saving medical treatments for their children." The Walkathon was dedicated to the memory of Niki Sedaris, founder of the Greek Division and a supporter of the New York Ronald McDonald House since it opened in 1978, who died in October 2011.

As the largest RMH in the world, the facility has 84 rooms that provide housing, programs and social services for the families of children being treated for cancer and other serious illnesses or injuries.

This year's event, which began at East 73rd Street, drew over 500 participants who donated \$15 each and walked three miles carrying red, white and blue balloons. Marathon participated at the Philanthropist level, along with numerous sponsors, helping to raise \$85,000. The event culminated with a brief ceremony, food, music and a performance of Greek Dances.

Supporting St. Jude Children's Hospital

On May 30th, another important fundraising event took place in New York, drawing hundreds of visitors, contributors and sponsors. This year's annual Kids for Kids Family Day for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital raised over a million dollars. The festivities took place at the Floyd Bennett Field in Brooklyn, and featured rides, carnival games, food trucks, ice skating, face painting, raffles, a silent auction and a BBQ lunch.

"In 2013, we raised a million dollars, a record for the hospital," says Michael Borrero, Chairman of the event, who worked hard this year to enlist enough support to break that record.

Since the Kids for Kids Committee was established in 2008, they have raised \$3 million for the patients and families of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Located in Memphis, Tennessee, the hospital was founded in 1964 by actor and comedian Danny Thomas, and in the five decades since has provided free treatment, travel, housing and food for the children being treated for cancer and other life-threatening illnesses, and their families. The hospital's groundbreaking research has helped push the survival rate for childhood cancer from less than 20 percent in 1962 to over 80 percent today.
