

Triumph Construction tapped for \$37 million infrastructure project

Brooklyn, NY Triumph Construction Corp. was awarded the winning contract by New York City's Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) for a \$37 million infrastructure replacement project on Flatbush Ave. in the vicinity of Sterling PI. and 8th Ave. in the Park Slope neighborhood.

Triumph will replace trunk and distribution water mains and combined sewer and appurtenances. The company will also be responsible for new curb extensions, street lighting, and traffic signal work in addition to the redevelopment of the 8th Ave. Triangle streetscape.
