- A mixed-use building at 751 Dawson St.: The five-story walk-up, located at the corner of East 156th St., contains 18 apartments and two stores. The building has 65 ft. of frontage and contains a total of 23,032 s/f. The selling price was \$3.51 million. The seller was represented by Joshua Banilivy while the purchaser was procured by Mark Singer.
- A commercial building located at 213 Bond St.: The building, in the Gowanus neighborhood situated between Baltic and Butler Sts., is a four-story building constructed in 2008. The building encompasses 4,100 s/f, not including two outdoor terraces. The selling price was \$1.125 million.
