Originally built in 1906, the 11-story commercial building features expansive windows, a lobby attendant and individual 24/7 key access. Designed by notable architect C.P.H. Gilbert, best known for his work on townhouses and mansions in the Gilded Age, 437 Fifth Avenue was referred to as the Knabe Building for decades after its longtime tenant the Knabe Piano Company. Today’s notable office and retail tenants include Summit Golf Brands, Bridal Reflections, Charitybuzz, Onward Search and Recruitics.

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
