1155 Avenue of the Americas was competed in 1984 and designed by Emery Roth & Sons. The building, LEED v4 Silver certified under the EBOM rating system (Existing Buildings Operations Maintenance), has undergone a \$130 million capital improvement program. 1155's upgrades include a new lobby, new elevator cabs and destination dispatch controls, new windows throughout and and an enhanced floor-to-ceiling glass condition that takes advantage of the the building's chamfered corners. In addition, a tenant exclusive 8,000 s/f custom roof-top pavilion with a 4,000 s/f wraparound terrace.
