Hamilton Cove, located at 800 Harbor Blvd., comprises three towers ranging from 12- to 15-stories high, all designed by Marchetto Higgins Stieve Architects as an homage to the surrounding neighborhood. The interiors were imagined by designer firm CetraRuddy.

Residences range in size from studios to three-bedrooms, some with private outdoor space. Each residence features modern-day finishes and materials including plank flooring throughout. The kitchens feature white Silestone Calacatta countertops and backsplashes, custom two-tone cabinetry, chrome Moen fixtures and integrated Whirlpool appliances. The bathrooms include white Porcelanosa tile floors, and white Silestone countertops. Every apartment comes with built-out custom closets and a Whirlpool washer and dryer.
