Which project, deal, or transaction was the "game-changer" in the advancement of your career? It was a co-GP platform investment I was part of at The Berkshire Group prior to joining MRA. Through a JV with LCB Senior Living, we were able to develop several senior living assets across the northeast corridor to stabilized yield-on-costs of around 10% before ultimately exiting at sub-7% cap rates. It was then that the metrics of real estate really started to make sense to me and I began to understand (and love) the real estate development industry.

I've been fortunate to have had several great mentors, including Joseph Farkas, the CEO of MRA and past bosses with whom I still keep in touch.
