Hempstead, NY Hofstra University broke ground at its local campus on June 10th, 2021 for its new 75,000 s/f Science and Innovation Center.

The building will house engineering and nursing programs, including classroom, laboratories, faculty offices and student space.

The \$103 million project was assisted by the issuance of tax-exempt bonds through the Town of Hempstead Local Development Corp. (LDC), which assists not-for-profit organizations in the town.
