Ortiz is also a published author of two books: Emotional Rooms, The Sensual Interior of Benjamin Noriega Ortiz (2007) and Suspending Reality, Interiors by Benjamin Noriega Ortiz (2014).

Positioned along the east side of the Shinnecock Canals, the 37-home Hampton Boathouses community offers residents spacious accommodations, amenities and water views from every homes' private patios and balconies. The community, which spans across seven buildings, offers two- and three-bedroom townhomes that have been designed to meet the aesthetic of the South Fork's manor-style homes.

As the COVID-19 pandemic shifted the flexibility to work from home for so many professionals, many seasonal renters are looking for a more permanent place to stay now that the distance

between the office and their home is no longer a factor. To help visualize a potential residents' new work/life balance with unmatched views of the Shinnecock Canal, a two- and three-bedroom furnished model home has been staged and is available to tour.

Residents will also have access to a dock equipped with 18 boat slips that will be available for lease.
