

REBNY adds NYC chefs to annual event, "New York Forever: A Celebration of Our City"

"It's exciting to contribute to such a great event alongside my peers, some of the best in the business," said Lomonaco. "The impact of the pandemic was felt similarly by both the real estate and hospitality industries, so it feels good to be able to work together as we all emerge stronger than ever."

"It's wonderful to gather in person again and to find ways to make people happy with food. Beverage offerings will also be curated by Brooklyn Brewery, New York Distillery, Tenmile Distillery and some of New York City's top mixologists.

A portion of event proceeds will go to the REBNY Foundation, which is helping to increase diversity and inclusion in the real estate industry through ongoing initiatives such as the REBNY Fellows Leadership Program in partnership with Coro New York and REBNY's Internship Program in partnership with Project Destined and the City University of New York (CUNY). The Foundation also supports ongoing efforts by Project Parachute – an initiative seeded by REBNY members in collaboration with the non-profit community – to provide rental assistance and other support to vulnerable New Yorkers impacted by the pandemic.

Additionally, REBNY's new partnership with the non-profit NY Forever on this year's event will help to amplify the work of an array of citywide volunteer and philanthropic initiatives promoted through the NY Forever network.
