



Ripley-Grier Studios expands to 62,257 s/f at 520 Eighth Ave.

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New York, NY GFP Real Estate, LLC has signed Ripley-Grier Studios to a 15-year lease for 62,257 s/f on the 10th, 16th, and 17th floors of 520 Eighth Ave. in the Garment District. A tenant since 1999, Ripley Grier Studios added an additional 11,152 s/f to its original 51,105 s/f.

With four locations located around New York City, Ripley-Grier Studios has provided studio and meeting spaces to the theatre, entertainment, teaching, and business community at 520 Eighth Ave. for more than 20 years.

The building is in close proximity to the Port Authority bus terminal and provides convenient access to numerous transportation lines, including the A, C, E, 1, 2, and 3 trains, as well as the Amtrak, LIRR and NJ Transit lines.

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
