In the past year, what project or accomplishment are you most proud of? In the past year, I have been most proud of watching my current team come together and the learning curve that happened with our project. We are currently working on occupational therapy housing units at Bellevue Hospital, a hybrid hospital, and a department of corrections project. There are many nuances that our team picked up quickly and excelled at. Every year, we have interns and an assistant project manager, and watching them grow and learn will continuously excite me.

Which professional associations or organizations would you recommend to women who are starting out in the AEC industry? I belong to two organizations in New York that I find to be excellent. On another, this was learning to manage five M/E/P subs and finding the middle ground between different designers.
