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Manhattan, NY Station Companies sold two residences in the anticipated 14 Second Ave. condominium development. These closings bring the total sold to three out of 10 units, even before construction wraps on the project. The condominium project is expected to receive its Temporary Certificate of Occupancy (TCO) in early June 2023.

All kitchens are equipped with a ventilation system that runs directly to the roof. Bathrooms showcase heated porcelain floor-tiles, Nubalado textured marble accent walls, and a white Zuma tub.
