

The Tatter Blue Archives Institute (TATTER) signs a 20-year, 3,600 s/f lease at Brooklyn Academy of Music's 230 Ashland Pl.

Brooklyn, NY Lee & Associates NYC announced that it has represented the landlord, BAM, (Brooklyn Academy of Music) and the tenant, The Tatter Blue Archives Institute (TATTER), in a new 20-year ground floor retail lease at 230 Ashland PI.

Starting in September of 2024, TATTER's new flagship will serve as a multifaced textile arts space featuring a café, library, and gallery, including special events, artist openings, public workshops, and a retail experience. Tatter will also be launching its first capital campaign this summer to further support its mission to celebrate culture and bring people together through educational programming and community events. TATTER explores the diverse medium of cloth to tell human stories and cultivate understanding.

"It is an honor to be included in BAM's embrace," said TATTER's founder Jordana Munk Martin. "Our presence at 230 Ashland in Brooklyn's Cultural District places textiles on a center stage, where they can do their work to inspire, express human identity, connect, and celebrate culture."
