We recently undertook a feasibility study for CHiPS, a food pantry in Brooklyn that provides housing for single pregnant mothers, to help the organization prioritize improvements to maximize efficiency post-pandemic. We've also partnered with the Bed-Stuy Gateway BID to develop design solutions for their Winter Wonderland, which has supported local small businesses and dozens of vendors annually since its 2020 debut.
