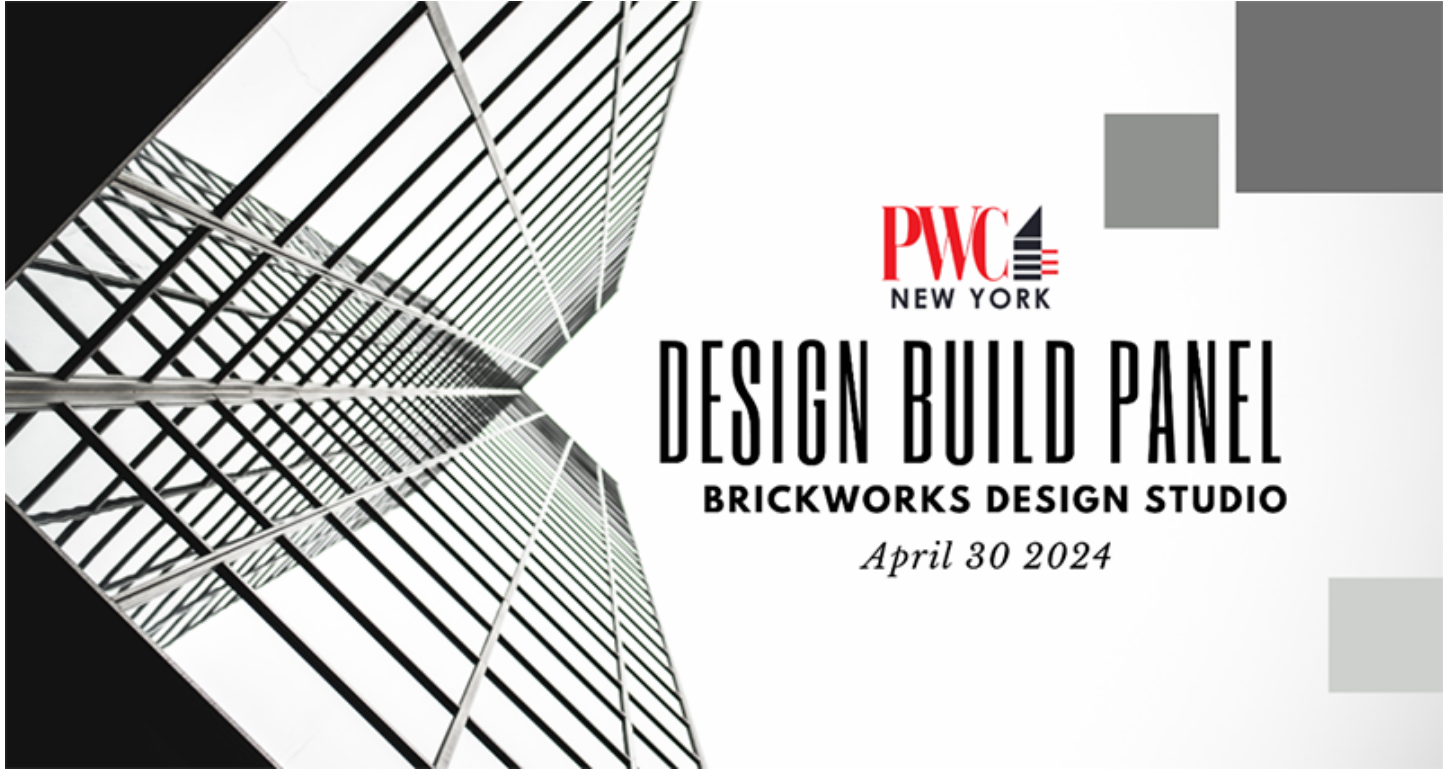




PWC to host Design Build Panel
