this month, will use the space as its executive and administrative offices. The furnished space, which was renovated in 2021, was previously occupied by Force Therapeutics.

10 Astor Place was built in 1876 by the architect Griffith Thomas in a neo-Grecian style and was originally constructed as a factory and printing office. This building stands 7 stories tall and encompasses 156,000 s/f featuring a recently renovated building lobby. The building features high ceilings and large windows offering an abundance of natural light. Located on Astor Place in the Noho district, the building is close to the buzz of the Village with NYU and Washington Square Park just moments away.
