In addition to Guy, moderator Thomas Hickey, AIA, healthcare project architect, associate vice president of CannonDesign welcomed speakers Terron Browne, project manager, design + construction, Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center, and Nathan Brzozowski, senior managing director, Integrated Consulting Strategies at Savills.

The Greater New York chapter hosts this series of programs that is both topical and conversational. The interactive session described the factors that affect healthcare system decisions regarding

targeted geography, size, and type of real estate that is needed, whether the asset will be leased or acquired, and the project delivery approach.

"Sometimes healthcare organizations come to us with a requirement to fill, and in other instances we are in the market and see opportunities that we bring to the institutions," said Guy. "Real estate often moves faster than healthcare, so we rely on our relationships. That's why Simone Development Companies focuses on partnering with healthcare organizations to meet their real estate needs."
