The full-service building is pet friendly, features a 24-hour doorman, Sky's the Limit Concierge Services, a laundry room on every floor and an attended parking garage.

Located between Riverside Park and Central Park, West River House is within walking distance to the American Museum of Natural History, the New York Historical Society and the Children's Museum.

The Calhoun School is located across the street from the property. Nearby transportation access includes the 1, 2, 3, B and C subway lines and multiple bus routes.

Dr. Reem received her Doctor of Dental Medicine from Temple University and her Certificate of Orthodontics from Einstein Medical Center in Philadelphia, PA. She specializes in airway-focused orthodontics, which develop the airway in conjunction with aligning the teeth.
