Jerry Taylor, a senior fellow at the Cato Institute, a nonpartisan public policy research institution headquartered in Washington, D.C., was the keynote speaker at a recent Greater New York Chapter of the Institute of Real Estate Management's monthly luncheon at the New York Helmsley Hotel. Taylor is among the most widely cited and influential critics of federal energy and environmental policy in the nation.
