



BOMA/NY to hold Annual Conference and Trade Show in fall

The act covers almost every conceivable technology including products, services, software/intellectual property and any combinations of technologies. We'll field a panel of both legal and security expertise to explain this new legislation, how to use it to the benefit of your operations, and how it will ultimately impact the industry's bottom line.

* With a City-mandated deadline for elevator and escalator inspections looming at the end of this year - including a \$2,500 penalty fine for each car/track not in compliance - our panel of vertical transportation professionals will walk you through all the steps you will need to take to ensure a smooth inspection process.

* Also in development are modules on the latest Local Law 11 requirements and a Best Practices session on how to deal with New York City Department of Buildings violations.

The Conference provides opportunities to visit the exhibits before and after programming, and during a break midway through the schedule. It wraps up with a cocktail reception from 5 to 7 p.m.
