

GreenbergFarrow designs 66-unit Zazza Williamsburg in Brooklyn

The 20-story rental property - which recently topped off construction - is being developed by Zazza Development Group, a New York City-based real estate development company led by Michael Zazza. The site is scheduled to open in September.
