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Omni to renovate Liberty Gardens: \$40 million project

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Omni Housing Development LLC has been chosen by the Rome Housing Authority to be its private partner in the complete renovation of the Liberty Gardens housing complex. These renovations to one of the largest affordable housing complexes in the Mohawk Valley, will offer safe, modern, affordable apartments to low-income residents and has the potential to revitalize the entire community.

Omni's proposed restoration calls for the gutting and complete renovation of the 180-unit complex. This renovation will be the first major upgrade at the property since its construction in 1952, and will provide modernized and energy-efficient units, meeting all regulations for handicapped accessibility under the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
